

Town of North River Minutes Meeting July 14, 2020
Held in Town Council Chambers 43 North River Road, North River, NL

There were two quotes received at closing.

G & J Excavating: Taxes included

Ditch behind ballfield bike path, supply & install 26" x 10 ft culvert & 1 load pit run, \$1725.00.

Calm Hole dog park area grub off and remove includes level off \$6900.00

Boat launch area supply rock, material & road gravel with excavator \$8050.00

Bert Snow: Plus tax

Ditching \$6700.00

Calm Hole dog park area \$24,500.00

Boat launch area \$3600.00

Agreed to hold off on Calm Hole dog park area until next year. See if any residents want to remove trees to cut down on contractors cost. Agreed no council members or family to benefit. Councillor Mackey to approach residents.

Question if boat launch quote if price includes supply & spread fill with class A on top & graded.

Further Resolved that invoice in the amount of \$828.00 from Bert Snow be paid.


